



Changes at Slate Bistro Due to COVID-19

In keeping health and safety in mind for both you, our patrons as well as our staff, there will be noticeable changes to the room and how our staff services you. Below is a list of activities and precautions that you can expect to see when you arrive at Slate.

- Table arrangements will be set differently; they will be arranged in a way to maximize social distancing. Guests are not allowed to move tables. Parties of 9 or more will be sat at separate tables.
 - We strongly encourage you to make a reservation as our seating capacity will be reduced, please call 480-988-5956 to make your reservation.
 - Please plan on arriving no more than 5 minutes before your reservation time to ensure our lobby can accommodate your group to assist us with distancing.
 - Our Red Veranda (patio with fireplaces) is now a Non-Smoking patio. Smoking will be allowed on our White Veranda (patio facing 10th tee) and outside the golf shop windows. The fireplace furniture has been relocated to this area for seating.
 - No consumption of any kind will be allowed at the Bar.
 - Expect to see Slate employees wearing face masks while working.
 - Hand sanitizer and sanitizer wipes will be available for all customers and employees.
 - We have been experiencing supply-chain challenges with our vendors and we expect this may continue as restaurants begin to open. Please be patient as we will do the best we can to ensure that we continue to provide a complete menu.
 - We will continue to: disinfect touch points frequently, enforce strong handwashing procedures and ensure all sick employees stay home and follow the CDC self-isolation protocol before returning to work.
 - We have implemented pre shift employee symptom screening including taking temperatures of ALL employees before beginning work.
 - We have trained all staff on updated procedures and protocols and will continue to do so as changes or new guidance becomes available.
 - We will continue to modify our operations as Arizona moves through their phased approach of reopening while erring on the side of caution.
 - We will continue to follow guidance from Governor Ducey's office, the Arizona Restaurant Association, and the Arizona Department of Public Health. All of which are following guidance from the CDC.
